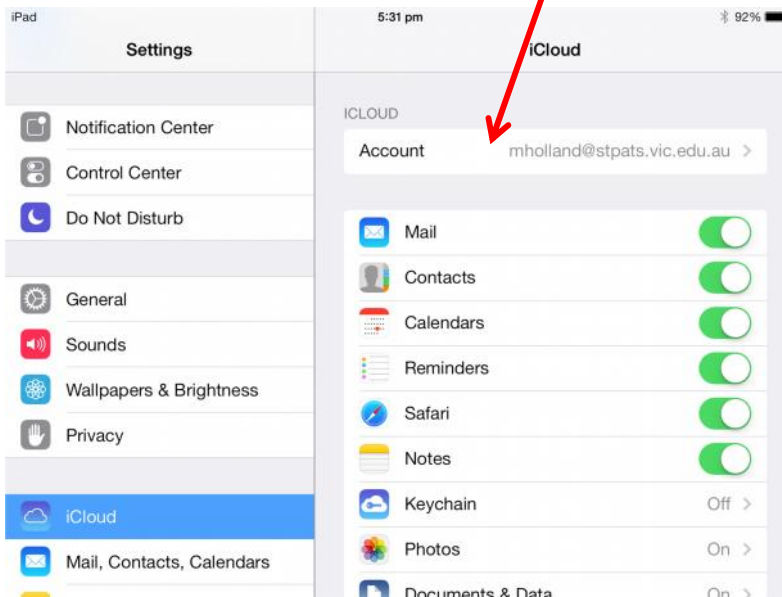
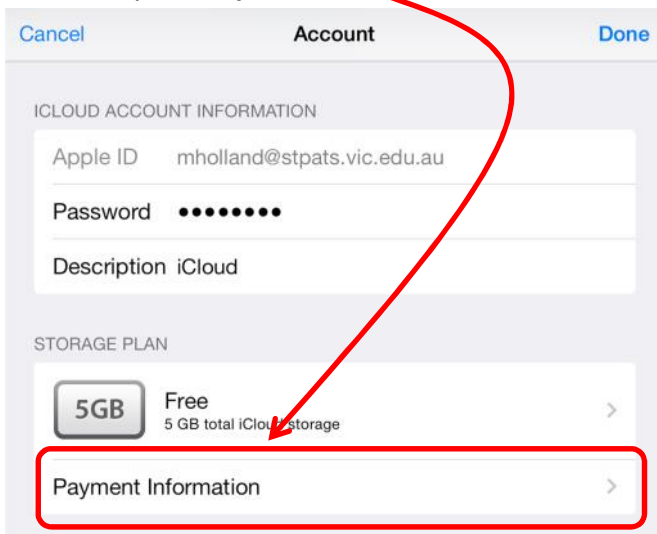


## Set Apple ID to 'None' Payment Method using iCloud

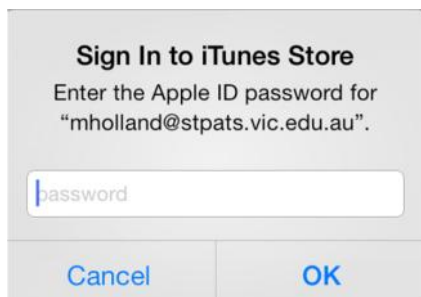
1. Click on *Settings/iCloud* and click on your account
